

PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS: LOCAL

Please read and follow these instructions carefully. Plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time.



PREPARING FOR YOUR VISIT

Chaperone/Legal Guardian

If you are a minor, a legal guardian must be present on the day of surgery.

Prescriptions

Please fill all prescription medication at least 24 hours prior to surgery. If you have misplaced your prescriptions, contact the office immediately. Allow 24 hours for prescriptions to be sent to your pharmacy.

Rescheduling

If you need to cancel or change your appointment for any reason, please remember to inform our office 48 hours in advance. Let us know immediately if you suspect that you might be pregnant, or your health changes, prior to surgery. If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact our office.



MEDICATIONS AND PRESCRIPTIONS

Routine Medications

Continue your normal medications unless instructed differently by your surgeon at your consultation. Patients taking blood thinners may require special consideration – this should be discussed with your surgeon. Contact our office if you have further questions.

Antibiotic Day of Surgery

Please take the prescribed antibiotic one hour prior to surgery as directed.
